BY BUS:

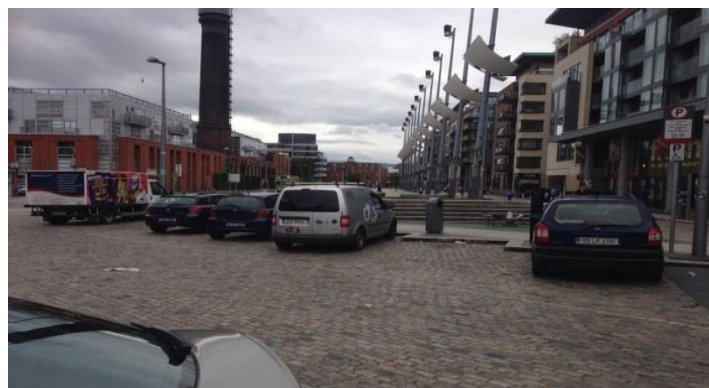
Dublin bus offers 100% wheelchair accessible stops nearby on Manor Street, around the corner from NWCI building, with controlled pedestrian crossings. Buses which stop in Manor Street, 37, 39, 39a, 39x, 70. For the latest route details and timetable information see www.dublinbus.ie

BY LUAS:

The Luas RED line Smithfield stop (100% wheelchair accessible) is located just 5 minutes' walk from NWCI building. The Smithfield LUAS stop provides easy access to the new cross-city LUAS which connect both the RED and GREEN line LUAS.
